Accommodation: 4 hotels **Campanile** (10 min far from the hall – 8 players), **Kyriad** (25 min. far from the hall – 7 players), **IBIS Gerland** – (25 min. far from the hall – 6 players), **IBIS Perrache** (25 min. far from the hall – 7 players)
Some of the rooms, bathrooms were acceptable for wheelchairs. Each hotel had 2 –4 rooms special for wheelchair users. Accommodation was based on bed & breakfast.
Lunch and dinner were served at the venue area and in the good quality.

Venue: Sport Hall was Ste Foys les Lyon, approximately 10 to 30 min by bus from all 4 hotels.

Playing hall: 4 playing tables for wheelchairs and 6 for practicing in the same hall

Floor: Gerflor

Lighting: suitable

Spectator seats: about 150 seats
for wheelchairs – directly in the playing area

Referee's table: in the playing area was checkpoint of referee.
Referee + computer man worked in the hall,

Gluing room: was near from the playing area,

Officials' room: no special room for them, officials used the office of the computer man.

The Organizing committee provided all participants with water every day. There was a buffed for the refreshment.

Wheelchair World Single Cup 2004 is one of the traditional ITTC tournaments.

It is possible to reproach to Organizers some deficiencies, for example:

- 1) During opening ceremony was published schedule for first round on big screen by introducing of each player. This system was very impressive for players, coaches and spectators
- 2) Some players had problems with height of tables (floor-table), no enough space for their legs
- 2) Not flags of participated countries in the playing hall

The timetable was prepared well and we always finished in approximately planed time. During the tournament we had no problems, if some, the Organizers tried to solve each one small pertinent problem quickly and with the smiling face.

World Single Cup was organized very well.
