Airport: Cluj-Napoka International Airport – about 40 to minutes to different Hotels.

Accommodation:

- 2) Hotel Sport *** (distance to the sport venue (> 1km)
- 3) Hotel Topaz***** (distance to the sport venue (+/- 4 km)

Meals: Breakfast and dinner were served in the hotel and a cooked lunch served at the venue.

Transport:

a.General: All transports were organized by RATUC from Mayor’s office “Speranta Remenyeg” Foundation, Lamont Centre with several accessible buses.

b.From from airport to Hotels:

Transport from airport to the hotels was organized well. At the airport were volunteers to meet the participants and they gave general tournament information.

c.from sport venue <> Hotel:

The daily transport schedule to the venue was good and it was possible to go to the hotel during the competition days.
