## **Transportation**

- The organizer will provide accessible shuttle buses equipped with lift for teams and officials from and to the airports.
- Local transportation (Accommodation-Venue-Airport) will be provided.
- About 2 hours From the airports to Accommodation (Normally less than 2 hours)

- Women's Singles (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10,11)
- Men's Team (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10,11)
- Women's Team (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10,11)

## **Schedule**

- Arrival of TD, Referees 26 April
- Arrival of players for Classification: 28 April
- Arrival of the teams: 28 April
- Classification: 28~29 April
- Practice days: 28~29 April
- Competition days: 30 April ~ 3 May
- Closing Ceremony : 3 May
- Departure: 4 May

## **Eligibility**

The participating teams must be from a full member of ITTF



## **Participation Rules**

A player may only play in the class that indicated on his or her international classification card unless, due to the low number of players, his or her class is combined with the next class or classes.

Then they may play in the next higher class event.

The minimum entry for a singles class to be played is 4 players.

The maximum number of entries per association per class is 6 plus 2 extra juniors.

The minimum entry for a team event to be played is 4 teams with 2, 3 or 4 players forming a team.

A maximum 2 teams per Association may be entered where all players are from the same Association.

Players from different countries may form a team in the team event, but if there are 3 players in the same event from the same Association, only the 3rd lowest ranked player may form a team with a player from another Association.

## **Persons on the Bench**

The following persons on the bench are permitted:

In singles events, 1 seat for a coach on the playing field (behind the surrounds).

In the team events 5 seats for one (1) coach (+ 1 additional if mixed Associations) and up to 4 players of the team playing the match.

No other players or personnel may have access to the area behind the surrounds or the playing area. Special provisions and seating areas will be made for medical personnel.



## Playing Rules

The event will be conducted in accordance with the current Laws of Table Tennis, the Regulations for International Competitions and specific PTT directives (which may be amended from time to time).

## System of Play

### **Singles events:**

The first stage will be played in a round-robin basis but there shall not be less than 3 and not more than 5 players in a group and priority will be given to groups of 4 players. If there are 5 or less players, the event will be played as a round-robin without knock-out. Two players advance from each group to the second stage which will be played in a knock-out format.

### **Team events:**

the first stage will be played in a round-robin basis with priority given to groups of 3 teams with the winner and runner-up in each group advancing to play in the knock-out rounds. If there are 5 or less teams, the event will be played in a round-robin format without knock-out.

Teams will play as follows: A vs X; B vs Y; Doubles; A vs Y; B vs X

### **General:**

The numbers of groups will be decided by the TD and the referee in cooperation with the organizing

committee. If the number of groups in an event is decided not to be a multiple of 2 (e.g. 2, 4 or 8 etc.), winners from the groups with the highest ranked seeded players shall have byes in the first round of the second stage, in ranking order.

All matches will be played to the best of 5 games.

Medals will be awarded for gold (1st), silver (2nd) and bronze (3rd) places

## International Umpire

International Umpires will be invited by the Organizers.

## Entry Deadline

First entry: by 28<sup>th</sup> February 2012

Second Entry: by 20<sup>th</sup> March 2012

**\*\*NO MORE ENTRY** will be accepted after the first entry deadline.

## Entry Fees

For PTT events, the entry fees include accommodation and capitation Fees. The entry fees have to be paid in Euro to the organizer as set out below.

For the period of 28<sup>th</sup> April~4<sup>th</sup> May: **€ 500 per** participant

Payment to be submitted with the first entry

**by 28<sup>th</sup> February 2012: € 150**

Payment to be submitted with the second entry



**by 20<sup>th</sup> March 2012: € 350**

Extra cost for additional day is **€60 per day**

Please note that **NO MEAL** will be provided for additional days.

The maximum number of players is **120**.

It includes:

transport from/to Airport/hotel, accommodation, full board; breakfast, lunch and dinner and €25 ITTF PTT capitation fee per person.

The first entry fee is a non-refundable deposit.

**\*Note: Every room is 4 bedroom. It is very spacious enough for 4 people to share with two bathrooms in a room.**

## **Entry Requirement**

Only entries submitted by or endorsed by the national associations will be accepted.

## **Meals**

The official first meal is dinner on 28<sup>th</sup>, April and the last meal is Breakfast on 4<sup>th</sup>, May.

**\*\*NO MEAL** will be provided for additional days.

## **Cancellation policy**

**The following policy applies :**

25.1 cancellations after the first entry but before the second entry: the first entry fee is forfeited.

25.2 cancellations after the second entry: the first entry fee plus an additional 30% of the entry fee per person is forfeited i.e. a total of 60% of the total entry fee per person.

25.3 cancellations within 10calendar days of the arrival date will be decided by the organizers in consultation with the TD

This is provided that the player is not able to prove circumstances beyond his or her control e.g. admission to hospital.

## **Insurance**

Each national sports Federation is responsible for the appropriate insurance for accidents, health, property and liability of their team.



## **Visas**

Should you need assistance to apply for a visa (e.g. a letter of invitation), please provide the organizers with the following details:

- Full name as in passport
- Date of birth
- Function in the team
- Passport number
- Passport expiry date

Note: the requirements for visas are not under the control of the ITTF or the organizers but under the Korea Government's jurisdiction and the association must fulfill all requirements in order to get a visa in time.

## **Television, Motion picture and Internet coverage conditions**

By entering the event, all participants agree to abide by all ITTF rules and by the rules and regulations of the organizers. All associations, teams and individual players agree to be abide by the rulings of the ITTF and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet web casting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture



coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind; and hence accept such coverage during the event. Any participant, when called upon, must appear promptly to press conferences or medal presentations and follow the procedures set by the ITTF and the organizers.

### **Seeding**

Seeding for all the events will be done according to the latest ITTF PTT ranking list at the time of the draws.
