A big lobby with tv, telephone and sofas.  
Breakfast and dinner were taked in the hotel’s dining room.  
The lunch were served on the competiton pavilion dining room.  
Dinner served on the table by dining room personnel, consisted of entrée, dish and dessert.

**Participants** : 3 nations were present      Argentina, Brazil and Chile
