<b>ARG</b>	X		The protest till the n° 107 in Men 3 and till the n° 52 in Men 5 can be understand but this slots are allocated to Greece host country ( in priority 2-3-4 slots)	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>
<b>ARM</b>	X		The player class 9 from Armenia was ranked and classified - the request from ARM was to taken in consideration but the player is not in position to can be selected !	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>
<b>BRA</b>		X	Due to the rejection from a player from France Alves is now selected by ranking and not by WC BRA enter again his request for WC/TTP ! We have not any free slot more to allocate !	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>
<b>BUL</b>	X		When we have to select players in a combined event, we have to look to the ranking points and not to the place in each class ! Moreover in women class 6-8 we have only 1 slot to allocate and we have to enter in the competition 1 lady class 6 !	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>
<b>CRC</b>		X	Till today, CRC is not in good standing with IPC, Moreover if the suspension is lifted end of April the player from CRC cannot enter in consideration CRC was not in good standing during 2003 , selection competition's periode !	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>
<b>CHI</b>		X	Chile have never enter a request fro WC/TTP After the doping violation from the player from BRA, the Silver winner from CHI is going up to Gold and is selected by regional slot, Only after this selection, CHI ask for a WC but out of the deadlines !	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>
<b>IRI</b>		X	This is not a protest but a request for WCs ! We have only 1 slot possible in each W class.	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>
<b>ITA</b>	X		In M 3 : 1 slot go to Greece host country the 2nd slot to NOR to complete a team with the player n° 1 in the world In M 7 :only 1 slot possible, go to UKR country in development with only 1 player selected In W 4 : only 1 slot possible, go to RSA country from A/ME, region where only 15 players in total are selected !	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>

KOR	X		In M 2 Korea have already 2 players selected and have also a team in M 1-2 In our rules is written that we have also to allocate WC to countries without selections It's the reason why we give a WC to ISL ! In M 8, the minimal number of teams is reached ! The Selection Committee decide to allocate 2 WC to 2 young players (16 and 17years) it's also in the selection rules.	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>
NGR		X	This is not a protest but a request for WC/TTP. All slots are given and if NGR don't have selected players, it's because NGR have not participate to tournaments since Sydney, except AAG - Abuja	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>
RUS		X	This is a request for TTP - to late !!! Moreover, all the slots are allocated !	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>
SCG	X		The problem is solved by the rejection of a player from FRA and the allocation of a WC to SCG	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>
SWE	X		We have not to take in consideration injury problems during 2003 ! (same problem as for the W. C. 2002 with the player from FRA) Moreover, the Sel. Com. , following the rules, cannot allocate 2 WC/TTP to a same country. SWE have already received a WC/TTP in M 6 and a team slot in M 6-7 !	<b>Not any change to the Selection Committee allocations</b>

**To have the possibility to allocate some WC instead of only TTP, the Sel. Com. decide to allocate WC when the minimum number of teams + 1 was already reached !**
