Accommodation:

OC prepared for the tournament two bigger hotels **GOLDEN TULIPE** ****, and **NOVOTEL** ****.

Hotel **GOLDEN TULIPE** full accessible hotel for the wheelchais with two lifts, everyone for two wheelchairs. In the hotel is together 130 double rooms, from the number are 60 rooms two single beds + 40 single bed rooms. Bathroom doors are in all of the rooms 68 cm and in the equipment there is good for the wheelchairs.

2 special rooms for tetra have big bathrooms + extra room for the staff. The dinning room is normally for 80- 90 persons, will be possible to use some place in the hall, before the dinning room for next maybe 30-40 persons for breakfast and dinner. Meeting room with needed equipment will be for disposition there too. Room for classification with TT table is in the basement too.

Distance from Venue is 5km, approximately 10min by bus.

Hotel **NOVOTEL** is fully accessible for the wheelchairs. Only one big lift for two wheelchairs is there. There are 128 rooms – from the number will be possible adjust approximately 90 rooms like 2 single bed rooms. All rooms have the bathroom's door 68cm, but will be necessary give out the doors (unfit placing of equipment there).

2 rooms with special big bathrooms for the tetra + rooms for staff are there. Dinning room 80 persons + smaller room next 20 persons and on terraca next 40 persons.

Small swimming pool on the garden.

For Farewell party is there one big room for 220+ dinning rooms, terraca + Bar – without problem for approximately 340 - 350 persons.

Distance from Venue 10km by highway, approximately 10min by bus.

Venue: Sport hall: **Sporthalle Kuellenhahn in Wuppertal**

2 playing halls: a) hall A, for standing for 12 tables.size 47 x 26m

b) hall B, for wheelchairs for 12 tables, size 29 x 26m both of halls in one building and very near one another

Tables: 24 pcs tables DONIC green ITTF, and ITTF PTT approved

Floor: wooden in both of halls

Lighting: not very good, OC will make the improvement of lighting Referee's tables:in hall A, on the tribune in the middle of its longer side

In hall B, on the middle of the longer side

Spectator seats: in hall A, approximately 200 seats on the tribune and

place on the platform, approximately for 20 wheelchair

spectators

In hall B, place on the platform approximately for

30 wheelchair spectators and 30 standing

Next rooms: relax room for umpires, TD + Referee room, OC room

change rooms for players, First Aid room, classifiers, Inform centre, snack, place for catering (lunch), gluing room,

and some nexts

Toilets: in the hall are enough number of the toilets for standing, now

only three special toilets for the wheelchairs. OC will rent the next mobile wheelchairs toilets for the tournament

Transport:

For the transport has OC prepare together 25 different buses (list of buses is enclosed). After the discussion with OC, during the meeting, I believe the number of buses will be O.K. for the both of transport – from all of three airports (Duesseldorf, Cologne and Dortmund) in to the hotels, and local transport too.

In conclusion:

EC of ITTF PTT endorsed T D Inspection in Wuppertal, which had to judge if condiction for German Open 2008 were really changed compared to last German Open 2007.

Why?

The German Open 2007 wasnt organized well. Durring the tournament, mainly wheelchairs, had a lot of problems, but problems were dirrectly in the playing hall too . The main Organizer was in the same time one of the players and couldnt solve problems continiously. OC was too small 'transport wasnt well organized.

The result of my TD Inspection now:

During the TD inspection, Jochen Wollmert + much bigger and better OC, informed me what they already prepared for the German Open 2008, up to this time :

- 1. despatched most of the problems during German Open 2007
- 2. changed the Venue
- 3. will use only two good bigger hotels for all of participants and officials
- 4. new transport officer will have much bigger number of buses
- 5. wont be problem with the places in the rooms for Farewell Party in Novotel + wont be problem with transport during the farewell Party and after its end to hotel Golden Tulipe.
- 6. they will prepare volunteers, like the helpers of wheelchairs, where and when it could be necessary
- 7. Every day will be in hall enough number of ballchildren + their organizer
- 8. Jochen Wolmert will be only Director of the tournament and wont player there too.

I am sure, the level of the German Open 2008 will corresponding with the other good ITTF PTT tournaments Fa 20.
