A total of 21 players were classified (Jordan -3, Saudi Arabia-5, Kuwait-1, Marroco-4, Palestine-1, Yemen-7).

JFSH will be organizer of Asia and Oceania Regionals 2009 OC from Al Watani Club, asked me in advance for the Test events in Spring 2009 (Fa 20). OC wants to organize it on equal terms as Regionals 2009 I am sure, Jordan could be for ITTF PTT very good and importent TT centrum of the whole Middle East.
<u>Conclusion :</u>	 Accommodation : was not perfect, but OC tried to solve the reminders of the participants. JorPC (JFSH) promised wont use next times already this hotel (Palmyra). Meal in the hotel was not bad Organization of the lunch in Venue had some time's problems with the suplier (hotel). Next time will be necessary to use the special caterer for it. Both of transport were organized very well, without some problems Organization of all of events was very good. The participants got, already in time, the Time schedule and referees and umpires adhered them well. Referee, Francezco Nuzzo, both of Deputy Referees - Qais Khresat and Khames Abdelfatah and all of umpires made, during the whole tournament, very good job. Classifier, Dr. Shamsul Azhar,managed the classification perfectly. Two young, but very good physiotherapits (from the military school) helped him very well. The job of ballchildren made very well the schoolchildren (8 – 12 years old). During the whole tournament some teacher organized their job in the playing hall. Ballchildren were very good prepared for their job there. In OC worked people from Al Watani Club and from JFSH. They Cooperate very well and therefore the organization of the tournament was very good, without some bigger problems. Medical sevice and First Aid organized Dr. Ali Alhadeed from the Military Hospital. Two physiotherapits and still one medic were present the whole time in the Venue. At the close of my TD Report, I'd like to congratulate to all of the Organizers, Officials and Volunteers for the excellent job. In Prince Raad bin Zeid Complex, they proved to prepare very comfortable and friendly environment for all of the participants. Therefore, on behalf of ITTF PTT I thank you all of them for it.
