<u>Evaluation</u> :	Accommodations : not suitable for wheelchair players at all. When inspection of venues and accommodation was made in June, management of the Flamingo Beach Hotel promised, that there would be 20-25 rooms for the November 2008 factor 20 tournament rebuilt/adapted for wheelchair users. Doors to bathrooms would be enlarged to 90 cm, holders/supports next to toilets and in showers would be installed as well as leavers on taps of sinks and showers would be installed. It was not done. At the last day before the tournament, when players were arriving they have made a few adaptations in showers of a few rooms, putting there chairs, so a		

wheelchair player could get under the shower, but without a help he/she would not be able to get back to the wheelchair.

The hotel seems to have a structural problem. Rooms on the side facing the sea had a very bad problem with condensation. The bathroom was continually wet with ceilings and walls dripping water. The walls in the room were damp.

Because of the above problems, perhaps the organizers could try to search for other accommodation for the future. Some of the wheelchair players were suggesting, that there are other hotels suitable for wheelchair users.

They have named LTI Coste Caribe beach, Pueblo Caribe, Isle Caribe, Hesperia Isle Margarite.

Venue :At the end of the day players seemed to be exhausted, because no air conditioning in the hall. Perhaps having a 4-day, instead of 3 day tournament could help. It should not be a problem for the regional championships, because it will be more than 3 days. Toilets not adapted for wheelchair users.

The organizers have promised during the inspection in June, that two cubicles of <u>toilets</u> in each of the change rooms would be <u>adapted</u> for wheelchair users (doors enlarged to 90cm and holders installed). Access to <u>showers</u> would be <u>adapted</u> by installing one ramp in each of the change rooms for access by wheelchairs and 2 showers adapted for using by wheelchair users. Taps in two sinks in each of the change rooms will be equipped by leavers to be wheelchair users friendly. At the last day before the tournament only 1 toilet's door was enlarged.

Some other suggestions for improvement

- making of signs with names of teams and numbers for indicating of scores of teams in teams events,
- make more room inside the hall, so the practise tables could be inside the hall
- try to get tables with legs 40 cm inside from the end line of the table. Those used at the tournament were not equipped that way, but at least did not have a crossbar under the end line.
