## Site inspection Czech Open 2011

The site inspection for Czech Open 2011 was done by Øivind Eriksen Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> September 2010.

The organizing committee was represented by Mr. Jiri Danek.

Czech Open 2011 will be organized  $7^{th} - 11^{th}$  September 2011 in Ostrava, Czech Republic. All classes 1 - 10 will be played.

The venue for Czech Open 2011 is, as in Czech Open 2009, the Sport Hall of TJ Mittal Ostrava. Two halls within the Sport Hall of TJ Mittal Ostrava will be used for the competition, one hall with up to 12 tables for classes 1 – 5, and one hall with up to 9 tables for classes 6 - 10. A third hall in the Sport Hall will be used for practice with 6 tables. The web address of the Sport Hall is <a href="www.tj-mittal.cz">www.tj-mittal.cz</a>. 2 - 5 accesible toilets for wheelchair users are inside the sport venue. If necessary mobile toilets will be placed outside the sport venue.

2 hotels will be used. Harmony Club Hotel, previous also used during Czech Open 2009 (only standing classes that time). The web address is <a href="www.harmonyclub.cz">www.harmonyclub.cz</a>. The distance to the venue is approximately 800 metres.

The other hotel is Park Inn, a quite new hotel, with up to 185 rooms. The web address is <a href="www.ostrava.parkinn.cz">www.ostrava.parkinn.cz</a>. It is also almost "walking distance" to the venue, approximately 1 km.

Transport between airport – hotel and hotel – venue will be done by buses and minibuses suitable for wheelchair transport.

Breakfast will be served in the hotels, and lunch/dinner in the venue. Ballboys, volunteers and umpires will be provided.
