Accommodation organized in 3 Hotels: 2 for players and officials and 1 for umpires.

Both of Hotels were full accessible for players and all arranged in single and double bed room.

The accommodation was very close to venue (5 minutes by walk) but the bus was ready to move participants to Venue and back.





Accreditation:

The persons who work in this tournament have a lot of experiences and worked well they gave a baggage to delegations includes:

Meals:

They arranged 20 vans that some of them were accessible for wheelchair and 2 busses, the sport hall was very close to Hotels but if somebody needs to go by bus it was available. There were 2 accessible busses.




Venue:

Sport Hall TRI LILIJE about 800 m from the Hotels, the venue was very close to accommodations and it was full accessible with 20 tables for matches ,there were enough water for participants (gallons & bottles) and next to venue there was coffee shop and drinks for refreshment. The venue had one lift and the OC arranged ramp on stairs but usable may be for class 4 &5.

Results:


The results were sent to the Ranking Director during and after the Competition days by TD.
