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**Accommodation:** Organizing committee used the Amaken Plaza Hotel \*\*\*\* and Palmyra Hotel \*\*\* for players , staff and officials in single or double bedrooms.

**Meals:** Breakfast and dinner were served in the hotels in good quality.  
Lunches which were served in the Venue in the special tent before the playing hall, were not bad too, but the composition of the meals could be more varied.

**Transport:** The transport among the Queen Allia Airport in Amman and hotels was organized well.  
The regular shuttle among the hotels and Venue was organized by enough number of buses and for standing and wheelchairs players too.

**Ball boys/girls:** Every day approximately 25 – 30 ball children + one organizer of them were present in the hall. They worked very well, during the whole tournament.

**Meetings :** A technical meeting was hold on April 3<sup>rd</sup>, at 7 pm in the Meeting Room of the Swimming Hall in the Venue. Organizer gave there to delegations the general information + draw and time schedule for the first playing day too.

**Classification:** Classification was conducted on April 3<sup>rd</sup> in the gymnasium beside the competition area. A total 21 players were classified including 1 reevaluated. The classifiers were Dr Shamsul from Malaisia and Mr. Marvan Dia from Jordan. OC prepared well the room and needed equipment for the classification.

**Results :** The final tournament results were given on CD ROM and in the Book of the Results, to each Delegation, during the Farewell Party. Digital results were sent by the referee, Mohamed Bassyoni, immediately after the tournament to webmaster Gael Marziou.

**Medical service :** During the whole tournament were present in the playing hall the nurse, the physiotherapy and the doctor from the Royal Military Hospital.

**Ceremonies:** Opening Ceremony was organized on April 3<sup>rd</sup> at 4 pm. President of Jordan Paralympic Committee, HRH Prince Raad Bin Zeid opened the tournament. Organizers prepared still very nice program with the national dances group. Medals Ceremonies were organized well, always after the finish of the events.

- Evaluation:** **Accommodations** – Amaken Plaza Hotel and Palmyra were accessible for the wheelchairs. Participants lived there in double and single rooms. During the first day, some of wheelchairs asked still for the plastic chairs to the shower. Later they haven't already some next problem with the accommodation there.
- Transport -** Transport from airport to hotels and local transport among hotels and Venue were organized without some problems.
- Sport equipment -** Good - new, ITTF and ITTF PTTD approved.
- Information:** Time schedule and draw were on the information board , all of next information were given directly from OC to delegations, but not by the help of the pigeonholes. For the next tournament I'd like to suppose to OC to use the pigeonholes still too.
- Referee :** good and professional work  
**Deputy referees :** good and professional work.  
 Therefore the tournament was in Arabic country and more than 60% of players were from the 7 Arabic countries, was very good, that Referee and Deputy Referees spoke their language.
- Umpires:** Good team, without some protest or other problems during the tournament.  
 Organizers invited umpires from abroad, but now one took the invitation. I supposed OC for the next tournament to offer umpires from abroad some help with travel expenses, therefore they need to have some other than Jordanian umpires for the tournament. They promised to negotiate about it with some sponsors.
- Computermen:** Very good team's work – always in time and well.
- Ball boys/girls** Always the enough number of them, well organized and instructed always by the present leader.
- Organization :** Every other tournament in Amman is better than the last. People from OC and volunteers always try to learn from the previous mistakes. This year was Organization of the whole tournament really very good there.
- Org. Committee:** Was helpful and cooperated with Officials very well. During the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of the tournament, they printed and distributed to all of players "*The Brochure for the table tennis players*" in the English language.  
 During the tournament was organized the simple Public Inquiry about the tournament. TD and OC asked all of delegation to fill in it. From 16 delegation , only 7 of them returned the fill in Public Inquiry back to OC.

This year in the Organizing Committee worked really the enough number of the people.

**Volunteers:** Relatively big team of people, which tried to help OC, but for the next tournament, I'd like to suppose OC to instruct them before more about the type of their duties during the tournament.

**About the tournament :** Among the participants of the tournament were 58 players from seven Arabic countries. Never, up to this time, we had in some our tournament Fa 20 or Fa 40, similar composition of the players. It tells a table, Amman's tournament could have, in the near future, very important for the players from the North Africa and whole Middle East. The Organizers try to learn to organize their tournament every times better as the last time. This year, we had only few small problems, which were always solved very fast. For next year OC want to prepare the place for the next 6 tables, with the similar level of conditions like in the big hall, to have possibility to invite more players for three days tournament.

**Congratulation to OC and to Officials, umpires, volunteers and ball-children too, therefore the organization of 3<sup>rd</sup> Al Watani Club TT Championships was really very good.**
