Recommendation	As can be seen, both bids are attractive with different strengths and several similarities. The major difference is that Italy’s association has applied while for China, the NPC has applied to host the event. From an event management perspective, both will be able to present a very good PTT World Championships. From a technical perspective, China has more space to accommodate the needs of the PTT World Championships. From an awareness perspective, Italy would have more impact. The PTT Division recommends that the 2014 PTT World Championships be awarded to China.
