Accommodation is at the distance to the venue about 40 minutes drive with busses.

**3)**

The timetable finished in approximately in time on the all days. We had playing plan from 9 a.m. to 20 p.m.

Referee Mr. Mohammed Bassyouni worked very professional with program of Dr. WU and with umpires.

Computer centre with Mr. Muhammad Smadi and Mr. Ammar Al Quadi – worked professional with program of Dr. WU.

**4)**

Good facility for table tennis tournament – there was too cold in the both halls – broken window in the main hall 1, which makes wind on two tables.

**5)**

Organizer managed birthday celebration to one player from Thailand – class 9 Thepmoya Wachiraporni (12.4.1983) with flowers and a gift.

Everyday were Jordanian TV in the sport hall and many newspaper representatives were presented during the tournament
