Ball boys: We had for the whole time of the tournament 15 volunteers (young men and women), which help us as ball boys too.

Meeting : A technical meeting was hold at 9.30 on December 2nd in the Venue. Firstly we had to specify the final list of the players and after it, the team leaders got all of the needed information about the tournament, including the preliminary time schedule. Draw of Open was made immediately after the meeting.

Classification: Classifiers had, following the list of Nico Verspeelt, to classify 4 players. They have from the organizers prepared the room for it with the massage table, TT table, office table and chairs. The players came in time. They observed them during the competitions too. The classifiers changed the original classes of two players, which they had from their countries. The closely before the start of the first competition came still one team of 5 players. They hadn't their ICC with them (forgotten them?) and it was problem. Classifiers made for them the new ICCs and check their classes in the data base of the Classification secretary. Both of classifiers made in Sharjah excellent job.



Medical servis : The doctor Ali Moh'd Hassan El Qadri and the nurse Chakib Chak Chouk were the whole time during the IWAS Games TT tournament present in the Venue and prepared to help, if will be it needed.

Drinking programme : The Organizers prepared for all of participants the natural water in the bottles without the limit of number of the bottles for the participants. All the participants had the possibility to take still coffee, tea, juice and different biscuits for free.

- Evaluation:** **Accommodations:** I hadn't possibility to check all of the hotels , but I asked the participants and all of them were satisfied with the accommodation and all of meals there,
- Transport:** Organizers managed the whole transport really excellent way. They use for it very big number of the big buses, accessible for wheelchairs. They had prepared the perfect ramps on the all of station of the buses. A lot of volunteers worked in the transport committee. Buses from hotels to different Venues were going always in the time following their time schedule.
- Sport equipment:** Good, all were ITTF approved.
- Light in the hall:** One day before, after I checked the level of the light in the hall I had to ask the organizers to try to correct the level of the light, therefore was under our minimal level of it. The Organizers promised it and added still extra lamps above all of four tables. It helped us a little and therefore we hadn't some protests before or during the tournament, we could the possibility to organize the play.

- Information:** Before the start, we had problems with the information for our table tennis tournament, but after the start it was already without some problems.
- Referee :** He was only alone for the tournament, no some Deputy, but managed the whole tournament very well and in time. All of events finished following the prepared time schedule.
- Deputy referee :** We hadn't Deputy referee and it was bad therefore Referee had, in the same time to lead the events, to prepare the sheets, to take the results and to made draw. For the next IWAS Games, I'd like to suppose you to applied the Deputy referee too.
- Medical service :** Was directly in the Venue. We were lucky, nobody from our participants needed some the health help.

- Umpires:** We had for the 4 playing tables only 4 umpires, but they made perfect job the whole three days of the tournament. We had no some problems on the tables. They managed it very well. For the next IWAS Games, I suppose to invite more umpires too.
- Computer man:** We had no computer man. Referee managed all his job with his own notebook very well.
- Organization :** I cannot speak about the organization of the other sports, but what I had possible to see, all was organized very well. The people which worked for the organization of the table tennis tournament made their job very well. They always were prepared to realize all of needed wish of our participants. They had the good knowledge of the organization of TT tournament and what they didn't know about some exceptions of IPTT Rules, they learned it very fast. The whole environment of the tournament was very friendly one. When I spoke with the most of the participants about it, they were very satisfied there.
- Org. Committee:** In the HQ of IWAS Games 2011 in Sharjah worked a lot of excellent and devoted people from the host country and the officers of IWAS HQ too. A lot of volunteers helped them beautifully.
A lot of times during the Games, they helped officials of sports wits their needs and sometimes special problems. It was for us not only very important, but very comfortable too. For me it was nice, I liked this type of the organization.
