<u>Accommodation</u>: Organizing Committee used the Hotel Eger & Park, for all participants, except the

Hungarian Umpires. Accessibility was good as noted in the inspection report 2011

**Meals:** Breakfast lunch and dinner in the hotel in high level quality.

**Transport:** The transport between Budapest and Eger was organized very well.

Because the weather was very nice we didn't need transportation between the hotel

and standing hall (5 minutes walking distance).

**Venues:** There were two different Venues:

Wheelchair hall



Inside the hotel a total area for  $750\text{m}^2$  (hall 5 and hall 4) with wooden floor used for 8 tables, *Lighting*: was enough 600 lux. No day light. Accessibility to the hall was without problem. Training site for all players were the halls 1-2-3 with 6 tables. Classification room was big enough inside the hotel near the training area. Pigeon boxes near the entrance of hall 4-5, for result board we used the wall near the organizing committee and a glass panel inside the hall 4.

Rest area was close to halls 1-2-3-4-5, big enough with a lot of tables and chairs for all, players, officials etc.

We used 8 tables full accessible for wheelchair players. **Referee's tables:** in the middle with good view

**Computer people:** by the referee place

**Wheelchair storage**: on the entrance of playing area

**Meeting room** : 20 meter from wheelchairs' playing hall

**Internet access**: Via Wi-Fi on ground floor and in the wheelchairs'

playing hall in the hotel.

**Offices** : we use the organizers office on ground floor.

**Standing Hall.** 





600m from hotel was the standing venue, dimension (42m X 22 m), wooden floor with poor quality wood with a lot of colours and especially the white one (problems with white ball). Lighting was enough about 700 lux, no day light. Gluing area was outside of venue but nobody was gluing. The standing venue was accessible only on ground floor for players but not for spectators. We used 10 tables.

**Referee's tables:** small table in the middle with good view

**Computer people:** near the referees table

**Accessible toilets:** in the Venue there were 6 toilets accessible for the

wheelchairs

**Ball boys/girls**: Every day approximately 15 - 20 ball children were present in both halls. They

worked very well, during the whole tournament. At the next time should be put in

quotation a coordinator responsible ever-present.

Meetings: A technical meeting was held on March 1<sup>st</sup>, at 19:00 pm in the Meeting Room at

1<sup>st</sup> floor of Hotel. Organizers gave general information + draws and time

schedule for the first playing day to delegations.

**Classification:** Classification Report

1/ Facility for classification very good prepared both room and equipment. Located in the hotel of accommodation of all players and PTT staff, very good accessible.

Big and high room with good floor and light. TT table, administration table with chairs, bench for medical testing good quality prepared. Waiting room with chairs and water.

Also refreshments for classifiers /water, coffee/.

#### 2/ According the PCF we classified total 15 players.

Classifications were done according the Schedule prepared with organisers according the arrival time of teams, avoiding waiting in front of the classification room. Started 29th. of February at 2 pm., continuing all afternoon and evening, and then next day 1th. of march from 9 am, and finishing at 2 pm. From this number was 1 review on demand of country, and 2 to confirm class at players not permanent, but under review. All others, 12, were new players, two of them ID athletes.

Results after classification and observation during tournament:

Review on demand country: no change of class.

Reviews not permanent classes: both classifications confirmed.

New players physically disabled: from the number of 10 was classified as 1 NE, all other 9 as eligible,

2 will stay under review in 2-3 years.

New ID players, 2, classified as eligible.

Copies of all classification cards added.

Re-evaluation fee 50 EUR, will be sent to classification secretary.

### 3/ General observations during tournament :

Player: DEN OTTE Patrick, classified in 2011 as class 7, seems to be during observation of better functional potential as is in functional profile of class 7. Due to his young age to be put on review within 1 year, not later ten next year European championships.

#### 4/ Others:

The touch function of touch screen used for ID testing seem to go quickly worse, and cousing big problems mainly during London tower test, what can affect objectivity of testing.
