Dear Friends from the Arab Table Tennis Community:

I am happy to announce some great news for the Arabic speakers!

The University of Leipzig (Germany), with the support of the German Foreign Ministry, German Table Tennis Federation and the ITTF are offering again an International Table Tennis Coaching Course BUT for the first time for Arabic speakers.

**The Conditions are as follows:**

**Course Duration:** 5 months

**Beginning:** 1<sup>st</sup> of September **2014**

**Finish:** 31<sup>st</sup> of January **2015**

**Course Language:** German with simultaneous translation to Arabic

**Scholarship:** Each participant receives a monthly allowance of 638.00 € which covers basic everyday necessities; a proportionate monthly fee (of 235.00 € at the moment) is deducted to pay part of the student hostel room rent as well as to cover a part of the health and accident insurance and the public-transport ticket for students. International airfare to Germany and internal transport to arrive Leipzig is NOT covered by this scholarship.

**Who can apply?**

- The 5-month continuing educational studies are open to applicants from developing countries as defined by the DAC list of the OECD\* who have completed higher education in the fields of physical education and sports or to those applicants who can prove an adequate qualification in table tennis.

– Applicants should have personal experience as active athletes or as physical education teachers/coaches in table tennis.

– Applicants have to prove mastery either of the spoken and written Arab [unless it is the official language in their country!] or of the German language.

– Applicants should not be over 40 years of age.

– Applicants must submit the results of a medical examination showing their physical and psychological aptitudes and load-bearing capacity as well as of the absence of internal and infectious diseases, including HIV and hepatitis. The reports must be completed no more than three months prior to the application deadline.

**How to apply?:** Via the **German embassy** of the applicant's home country

**Applications' DEADLINE: 1<sup>st</sup> of MAY 2014**

**ITTF Certification:** After an agreement between the University of Leipzig and the ITTF, the study program includes the Syllabus of the ITTF Level 2 Coach Education. That means those already certified as ITTF Level 1, have the chance to be certified as Level 2 if taking this course.

For those reasons it is recommended that those applying get an ITTF Level 1 certification

**Applicants' Selection:** It is **done by the University (NOT ITTF)** applicants with an ITTF Coach Certification will be prioritized.
