Accommodation

The hotel Eger Park was used for everyone except the umpires. Accessibility was good. There was no complaints from the umpires about their hotel.

Meals

Meals taken at the hotel was of good standard. No meals were taken elsewhere.

Transport

Transport between Budapest airport and the hotel was well organised. Transport between the hotel and the standing play hall was not required due to the short distance (approx. 500m). No transport had been arranged for the umpires, most had their own transport.

Venues

Two separate halls were used:

Wheelchair Hall - (8 tables) Occasional problems with the lights going out on the first day, but the hotel staff corrected the problem efficiently. No natural light in the room. The referees table was situated at the end, with a good view also on this table was a computer person inputting results. The call area was at the entrance to the hall.

Standing Hall (9 Tables) Approximately 500m away in a separate sports hall.

The floor was mainly white therefore Orange ball were used. The referee's table was in the middle with a good view of the playing area. The computer person was also on the table. Due to a lack of entries in the sitting classes class 6 men and 6-7 women was scheduled to use wheelchair courts at the hotel for the singles events only. The call area was in the entrance to the building with direct access to the playing area.

Every day approximately 15 – 20 ball children were present in both halls. They

worked very well, during the whole tournament.

A technical meeting was held on March 11th , at 20:00 hrs. in the Meeting Room on the 1st floor of the Hotel . Organizers gave general information + draws and time schedule for the first playing day to the delegations. The umpires briefing was held at 21:00 hrs.

Classification report:

HUNGARIAN OPEN 2014 - EGER

Classification Report

1/ The venue for classification very good prepared, both room and equipment.

Located in the hotel of accommodation of all players and PTT staff, very good accessible.

Big and high room with good floor and light. Two working places for two classification panels with TT tables, administration tables with chairs, bench for medical testing were prepared. Waiting room with chairs and bottled water.

2/ Classification process.

Because of really big number of athletes for classification, new physically disabled and ID and also reviews, *the classification schedule was prepared in advance with organisers* according to arrival time. This way all the teams were announced about classification schedule directly by coming to the accreditation. This made the classification process fluent and without confusion and waiting.

Even there were some athletes more for classification as new, or review, that were not on the PCF, but officially entered. This was also solved in cooperation with these teams.

We started on Wednesday morning, continued to late evening, than all Thursday till 5 PM, when the classification results were announced to referee and TD for draw. Computer testing of cognitive functions of ID athletes continued to late evening and was finished on Friday.

During this time all 4 classifiers were really fully involved in direct classification process in two classification panels.

During this time *we classified 42 athletes.*

Physically disabled: **26 New, 3 Rew. on demand, 2 under Rew. Total - 31**

Intellectually disabled: **5 New, 6 under Rew. /1 of these as NE/ Total - 11**

All the other were eligible. Many classes were changed in comparison with enter class.

After observation during tournament matches, classes of 2 athletes were changed.

All final classification results are in the completed PCF

Cooperation with organisers and PTT staff was excellent.
