## 1. Accommodation:

All athletes, staff, umpires and officials were staying at Hotel Eger & Park. Rooms were accessible for wheelchair players.



**2. Accreditation:** Was held on arrival next to the lobby. Everyone received accreditation card.

**3. Meals:** Breakfast, lunch, dinners were served in hotel at very good quality. Water was solved by water tickets on both halls in 1,5l bottles.



**4. Transport:** The organizer provided transport from Budapest airport on very good quality. They had transportation manager, in case of any problem he was available on call. They also provide transport to second playing hall for Standing athletes. Small buses and vans were available every 30 minutes and during busy hours fluently.



5. **Venue:** The tournament was divided into two playing halls

**Wheelchairs hall:** was at the 1st floor at hotel with 750 m<sup>2</sup> on the wooden floor. We used 5 wheelchair accessible tables. Lightning was ok with 600 lux and no daily light. Accessibility was very good. On call was available also mechanical service. The practice hall was next to the playing hall with 5 tables. Classification room was big enough close to the practice hall. The draws and information were published inside the playing hall and also next to the reception and Organizing Committee.

Referee table was in the middle of the playing hall with good view. Ball bays were on call very good organized.



**Standing hall:** Eszterhazy University Hall

Distance from hotel was 1700 m. Dimension of the hall was 42x22m with wooden floor and 8 tables ( 7playing tables) Lightning was 650 lux, no daily light. The venue was also accessible for wheelchair athletes. In the hall were spectator's area, rest area and call room.



**6. Racket control** : no official racket control , just Call Area procedures from the umpires

**8. Classification:** was held next to the competition hall. 25 athletes were attended on PCF. Only 1 athlete entered to the competition was classified as not eligible for PTT competitions after complete classification process, including observations.

Classification: 15 March (afternoon) and 16 March (morning)

Technical meeting and draw: 16 March

Competition days: 17-18-19 March

During the tournament results were regularly published on the information board in both playing halls, also updated more than 3 times per day on the IPTTC website.

## 11. Ceremonies:

The Medal ceremony for Single Events was held on wheelchair competition hall at the hotel.
