## 2002 Table Tennis Sports Assembly

Dear Secretary General:

You have been considered a country widely practicing table tennis in the past but have not participated in a table tennis tournament approved by the table tennis SAEC within the last 30 months and are not included in the current table tennis ranking list.

Your country is therefore at the moment granted an observer status at the Table Tennis Sports Assembly which will be held during the 2002 IPC World Table Tennis Championships. Please note, that observers have the right to attend the SA, but are not granted voting rights during this meeting.

As stated in the IPC Handbook Section III, Chapter 4, Bylaw 1.1.1.3 a country shall be considered widely practicing a sport if:

- National Championships have been held on a regular basis, at least every 4th year, or
- A National Team has participated in the international competition and championships program of the relevant sport at least twice within two consecutive competition cycles of the sport.

As a time span the IPC considers the last 4 years to evaluate your participation.

If you can prove that your country fulfills the above mentioned criteria, please submit the results of the tournaments you participated within the last 4 years as soon as possible. Your status will then be reviewed and you will receive additional documents (mandate, nomination and motion forms) for the assembly, if appropriate.

In addition to the observer form, please also find enclosed the following documents prepared by the Table Tennis SAEC:
