Airport: Düsseldorf about 40 minutes drive to Wuppertal

Accommodation:

Some rooms are special for wheelchair users in limited number in Pavilions. One lift for two wheelchair users in the hotel.

<u>InterCityHotel</u>, Döppersberg 50, D-42103 Wuppertal, Tel: +49 (0) 202 – 43060, about 2,8 km far from the venue

<u>Ibis Hotel</u> – about 3 km far from the venue – dinner was served in the nearest restaurant Diebels (300 m far from the hotel)

Best Western Hotel – for umpires

Breakfast and dinner were served in the hotels. Meals were served on the buffet basis - in very good quality. Lunch was served at the venue (from 3 choices) – bonus tickets were used (see the picture 3)

Transport: Transport (from Airport to hotel and back,) was organized with some delay.

Every day with delay from the Hotel Ibis, Intercity and Best Western hotel (for umpires).. The organizing committee had possibility to use the sufficient number of wheelchairs

acceptable buses and minivans. Some players used taxi to/from the venue.

Organizer promised that there will be some volunteers to help wheelchair users at the hills

from the busses to the hall – no one was there!!

Meeting: There was the meeting for team leaders on September 12, 2007 at the evening at 2100.

EDP: Umpiring course for umpires held on September 12, 2007 at 1700. The five umpires past

the test in English and two in German. Those tests were sending to the Tournament officer

Mr. Karol Ziduliak.

Due illness of Mr. Peter Heedt, the second classifier was Mr. Aart Kruimer

Medical services: Medical service - doctor was present the whole time during the tournament. During

the tournament there were 7 professional physiotherapists - free of charge for all

participants.

Wheelchair service: not evadible in sport hall – just on call

Ball boys: During the tournament were enough ball boys presented for wheelchair players.

Well knowledge about Table Tennis.

On Saturday there were no ball boys at all. Some umpires and staff of

participants replaced their duty!!!

Final evaluation:

<u>Accreditation</u>: all participations were transported from airport to the Mercure Hotel, re-transport to their hotels was with the problems, due transport from airport.

Recommendation for future tournaments:

Bring only one person from each team to the accreditation!

<u>Accommodation</u> – in the hotel Mercure – 80 % of rooms was reserved with king size bed only, no double beds.

Transport during the tournament:

Big busses were stopped about 200m far from the hall at the hill. Organizer promised that there will be some volunteers to help wheelchair users at the hills from the busses to the hall – <u>no one was there!!</u> Transport delay from the lbis Hotel and Best Western daily. For the transport were buses suitable for wheelchair users.

We had some problems with authorization of draw system Dr. Wu – even after authorization there were mistakes in classes, system did not accept changes. Due re-draw (mistakes in first draw), we was late. The timetable finished later after the planed time. We played from 9 a.m. to 22, 30 p.m.

In the sport hall was possible to drink bottled water in 1,5 l.

Technical service during the tournament:

There was no special person for copier – from the beginning; TD did all copies, because no one can work with copier, no person who put up updates on the information desk in the Uni hall. Second day there was one volunteer.

Computer centre and Referee used only one printer – waiting until one of them finished printing!!

At the first day we had difficulties with the Internet connection. Each organizer has to have access to the Internet – regarding to the information from IPTTC web or connection to the selection officer or another issue.

Only one responsible person (Jochen Wollmert) who can make decisions played also on this tournament.

Director of the tournament cannot be a player at the same time!!!

Prize money – rather than prize money, to have enough personnel who will run the tournament!!! Only two people as organizing committee – transport – information – copier – hanging results on the information desk etc. This way it cannot work!

<u>Farewell party</u> – started about 22,30 in Diebels (restaurant where Ibis and Best Western had their meals) – transport was reserved till midnight only – so all participants from hotels Mercure and Intercity had to use the taxi. The restaurant was not for such numbers of people (about 350 +) and special for medal presentation.

Recommendation for the future tournaments.

More people in the Organizing Committee (translator, copy, volunteers....), better technical equipment (PC, printers,), one day more for this number of participants!
