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| <p>Situation</p> | <p>Weather: Sun 30 degrees</p> <p>History : Surakarta name used in formal contexts, while the Solo name for an informal context. The suffix refers to the city-Djakarta, and Surakarta city still has a close historical relationship with Kartasura. Solo name is derived from the village of Sala. While Indonesia still adhered to the spelling of Repoeblik, city name is also written Soerakarta.</p> <p>The name "Solo" is given as the name of "graduation" for the new government center. The existence of this city began when the Sultanate of Mataram move the position of king of Kartasura to the village of Sala, on the banks of the Solo. Officially, the palace began to be occupied on 17 February 1745. Due to split the kingdom, in Solo stood two palaces: Kasunanan Surakarta and Praja Mangkunegaran, making the city of Solo as a city with two administrations. The second political power of this empire was liquidated after the founding of the Republic of Indonesia on August 17, 1945. Over the past 10 months, Solo status as a provincial-level regions, known as Special Region of Surakarta. Furthermore, because the growing movement in Surakarta antimonarki and unrest, kidnappings, and murders DIS officials, then on June 16, 1945 the government of Indonesia DIS dissolve and eliminate the power of kings and Mangkunegaran Kasunanan. Status Susuhunan Surakarta and Duke Mangkunegara become ordinary people in society and the palace is converted into the development of arts and cultural center of Java. Solo later determined to be the seat of the prefect, in charge of the residency of Surakarta (Residentie Soerakarta) with an area of 5677 km² area. June 16 is commemorated as the anniversary of the modern era Solo.</p> <p>After Surakarta abolished on July 4, 1950, Surakarta into town under the administration of Central Java Province. Since the Local Government Act which gives more rights to local government autonomy, Surakarta, a city of the autonomous region status.</p> <p>Special: Solo was once known as Surakarta and back then this town was the citadel of Royal Javanese Empire. However though the glorious days are over; the reminiscent of the legacy in terms of palaces and other imperial constructions still remains in Solo. These palaces attract a lot of tourists from all parts of Indonesia and from around the world as well. Apart from the royal households, the vicinity of Solo is dotted by temples. These temples with beautiful carvings on the walls testify to the rich craftsmanship of the then people. Therefore things to do in Solo inevitably comprises of visiting these places.</p> <p>Things to do in Solo should start off with a visit to Candi Ceto. The temple is one among the last Hindu temples which was built in Java before the royal court embraced Islam in the 16th century. Located at an altitude of 2200 meter, the journey to this temple is breathtaking to say the least. To enter the temple; you have a pay a nominal fee but considering the carvings on the temple walls this place is worth visiting.</p> <p>By paying just a nominal fee, you can explore the royal palace on a guided tour. The tour contains looking at royal household with grandiose furniture, portraits and the chandeliers. The royal ancestors moved to this palace in the mid 18th century. However, unfortunately the palace was destroyed in 1985. So the palace that now stands on the ground is a reconstruction of the original one's.</p> <p>Visiting the Kraton, that is palace, is another major part of things to do in Solo.</p> |
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
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| | <p>The museum of this Kraton can be explored on a guided tour. The museum boasts of an enviable collection of foreign jewels. The crystals and diamonds from Belgium would surely catch your eyes.</p> <p>Tasting local food is another best thing to do in Solo. You can taste local Solonese food from local street vendors. The mobile kitchen of the street vendors is called Kaki lima. You can taste a bowl of salad or steaming hot mee basko. The food tastes great.</p> <p>Besides shopping activity also forms a major thing to do in Solo. You can buy batik, fresh grinded coffee and a lot more from the local markets. With hundreds of shops selling batik and fabric clothes; the Klewer Textile Market in Solo is a good place to buy such items. You can also buy antique items in Solo at the Triwindu Antique Market.</p> |
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

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


