Distance between Hotels and Venue: Both hotels 5 minutes by coach or 10 minutes' walk.

Transportation: Shuttle buses start 7:00am from hotels and every 15 minutes all day.



Meals: All meals were served at the hotels, the quality and variety were very good.

Breakfast: 06:30 – 10:00 **Lunch:** 12:00 – 15:00 **Dinner:** 18:00 – 22:00

Venue: Sports hall Tri Lilije, Poženelova ulica 22, Laško

Fully accessible for wheelchair users. As the competition was taking place in the first floor, 2 elevators were available for wheelchair players. Next to venue entrance was a Café / Bar.



Referee and TD Table: Close to the playing area in the middle of the hall.

Spectator Seating: 500 seats available with a good view of the playing area.



Practice Tables: 12 x SAN-EI Blue wheelchair friendly tables – Not enough for 350 players.

<u>Changing rooms</u>: 3 changing rooms, 6 bathrooms – 3 wheelchair accessible toilets.

<u>Call Area:</u> Standing players at one end of hall and Wheelchair players at other.

Water: Water machines at each end of the playing hall.

Equipment (All ITTF approved):

Floor: Taraflex red floor.

Lighting: 2 readings taken giving average of 1000 lux.

Tables: 20 tables SAN-EI blue wheelchair accessible, (12 for standing, 8 for wheelchairs)

Nets: SAN-EI

Balls: XUSHAOFA Seamless 3* White 40+ **Scoreboards and Umpire's tables:** SAN-EI

Towel boxes: SAN-EI Surrounds: SAN-EI <u>Classification:</u> At Hotel Wellness Park – For class 11 only. Plus review, re-evaluation & protest.

Results Service: The computer person entering results next to the referee team.

Medical service: Available everyday throughout the tournament. Ambulance present. **Information Boards:** Updated regularly throughout the tournament at venue and hotels.

Wi-Fi Internet available to everyone at hotels and venue.

Opening Ceremony: There was a short opening ceremony at the beginning of the tournament

Medal Ceremony: All medals was presented at the farewell party in Wellness Park Hotel.
