## PARALYMPIC GAMES - ATHENS 2004

## 1. Allocation of slots by category:

| Regional slots: | $30 \%$ of $240=72 \rightarrow$ adjusted to $\mathbf{7 2}$ slots |

| Ranking slots : | $60 \%$ of $240=144 \rightarrow$ adjusted to $\mathbf{1 4 4}$ slots |
| ITTC - WC slots : | $10 \%$ of $240=24 \rightarrow$ adjusted to $\mathbf{2 4}$ slots |

| 1.1 Regional slots |  |

Priority : GOLD in all classes in each Region for Men and Women

- maximum slots allowed: $\mathbf{7 2}$ slots
- 40 Gold men slots as maximum
- 28 Gold women slots as maximum
- 4 Silver men slots go over to the Ranking Allocation system (IPC accept only the Gold winners selection!)


### 1.2 Ranking slots

144 slots to be shared for the remaining $60 \%$ allocation in each event for Men and Women

- 113 men slots as maximum
- $\quad 31$ women slots as maximum


### 1.3 IPTTC - WC slots

24 slots include Wild Cards and Team Target Players to be determined by the ITTC Selection Committee. These athletes have to have as a minimum an International Classification Card and current valid ranking points on the ITTC ranking list as of December $1^{\text {st }}, 2003$.

- 17 men slots as maximum
- 7 women slots as maximum
- 4 of the total of slots shall be proposed to the Host Country (GREECE) but only 1 slot can be used for a the same category/class as maximum !


### 1.4 Comments

In case an athlete/NPC does not accept a selection of a Regional Winner or medallist (injury, or rejected by NPC), the next highest finisher in that event takes the Regional slot.
Example : If the Regional winner in the Pan-Am Championships - men class 6 did not accept the selection, he would be replaced by the Silver medallist in the Pan-Am Championships-men class 6.
If the Bronze medal winner is also rejected, the Regional slot shall go over to the Ranking slots and the respective Alternate player shall be moved up in order of ranking.

If medal winners are missed because no Regional Championships was organized, or an event did not have enough minimum entries, all those Regional slots are converted into Ranking slots and the respective Alternates are moved up in order of ranking.

If in the Ranking category, players are rejected by their NPC, the Alternates go up in order of ranking.
An NPC does NOT have the right to replace a selected ranked athlete !

### 1.5 Selection conditions

To can be selected, an athlete has to have :

- an International Classification Card (new system in effect on December $\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}, \mathbf{2 0 0 2}$ for standing players),
- current ranking points as of December $15^{\text {th }}, 2003$
- his/her Country has to be in good standing with the IPC

## 3. To all Regional Championship Organizers in 2003

## All Regional Championships must use the same event format as the Paralympic Games.

If for any reason, a Regional Championship uses another format of events and will combine other classes, the Main TD of that Regional Championship must send a report to the Selection Officer.

Final decisions about splits or mergers of classes are taken by the ITTC Selection Officer.
