In March 30<sup>th</sup> from 3:30 to 5 pm , Referee with the help of Deputy referee made the training seminar of umpires in the Venue.

**Ceremonies :**

OC prepared very nice **Opening ceremony** the day before the start of the tournament at 5 pm in the Venue. After the opening session by His Royal Highest, Prince Raad Bin Zeid, was prepared next nice programme. Firstly the small children and after them, the older girls danced and sang the national songs and dances in the folk costumes.

**Medals ceremony** were after every competition and were well organized.

**Clothing Ceremony + Farewell Party** were the last day of the tournament from 9 pm, in the hotel Palmyra. The organizers, except others, turned nice reminders over to all of delegations and Officials there too.

**Classification :**

The classification of the players was done on 31<sup>st</sup> March at the Venue.

The physiotherapist room was used for that purpose ( with table, chairs and an examination couch.).

A TT table was placed in the nearby gymnasium. Two local physiotherapists helped in the interpretation and negotiation.

A total of 21 players were classified (Jordan -3, Saudi Arabia-5, Kuwait-1, Marroco-4, Palestine-1, Yemen-7 ).

### Conclusion :

1. Accommodation : was not perfect, but OC tried to solve the reminders of the participants. JorPC (JFSH ) promised wont use next times already this hotel ( Palmyra ).
2. Meal in the hotel was not bad
3. Organization of the lunch in Venue had some time´s problems with the suplier ( hotel ). Next time will be necessary to use the special caterer for it.
4. Both of transport were organized very well, without some problems
5. Organization of all of events was very good. The participants got, already in time, the Time schedule and referees and umpires adhered them well. Referee, Francezco Nuzzo, both of Deputy Referees - Qais Khresat and Khames Abdelfatah and all of umpires made, during the whole tournament, very good job.
6. Classifier, Dr. Shamsul Azhar, managed the classification perfectly. Two young, but very good physiotherapits ( from the military school ) helped him very well.
