the next tournaments too.

**Transport -** Good organized transport from airports to hotels and back.

Therefore small distance among the hotels and Venue, OC didn't organize regular shuttle, but by the hotels and by Venue was possible to ask for transport. Minibuses were there always

prepared.

**Sport equipment -** Good, ITTF and ITTF PTT approved.
