**Accommodation**: All the participants of the tournament stayed in the hotel AC Arganda \*\*\*\*,

in singles and doubles-bed rooms. The accommodation was arranged well and the hotel was good for standing players. We hadn't any problem with the meeting room with the right equipment there and with the dining room too. Free internet connection was both in the hall than in the lobby of the hotel and all the participants have the possibility to use it.

Meals: Breakfast and dinner were served in the hotel, lunch in a restaurant in the Venue and meals were good in both places.

Transport:

On the arrival day of the delegations the transport between the Airport of Madrid and the hotel AC Arganda had some small problems and the same situation happens with the local transport the first day too. From the second day it runs without any problem more. Local transport was organized with mini-buses. During all playing days we used the shuttle service following a handed out time schedule.

**Meetings:** A technical meeting was hold at 9 pm. on the arrival day in the hotel

> AC ARGANDA. There the organizers gave the necessary information to the delegations. The draw of Open Singles was made there and it was distributed to

the delegations including the time schedule for the first two days.

**Classification:** 12 players were classified (5 new players, 7 players for review). 4 players of

Nigeria did not arrive. Two players were classified in a different class than they had got before in their national classification. On request of OC, 3 local athletes more were classified. 2 of them did not meet the minimal criteria to be eligible in

a disable tournament, one was classified in the wheelchair classes.

The equipment and space for the classification was sufficient and the support excellent. The communication to the athletes about the classification time and the

place should had been earlier.

Classification was made very kindly, but professionally, with good help from the

Organizing Committee.

**Results:** During the Rivas Vaciamadrid Open, the results were sent to the ITTF PTTD webmaster,

after each specific event.

The final results of the tournament were given on a CD ROM to each Delegation,

during the Farewell Party.

All digital results were sent on October 12<sup>th</sup> to our webmaster Gael Marziou.

**Medical service:** The Medical Center in the Venue supported the medical service for the

participants of our tournament too.

**Ceremonies**: A short Opening Ceremony was organized on October 7<sup>th</sup> at 3 pm. The Medals

Ceremony for all the events of the tournament was organized in the Venue on October 10<sup>th</sup>, after the end of the Team events. At evening, all participants were invited for a nice Farewell party to the Spanish traditional restaurant Posada for

special local meals and good wine.

**Evaluation:** Accommodations - The accommodation in the hotel AC Arganda was very

good and the meals (breakfast and dinner) were of good quality

too.

**Transport -** Wasn't bad, but for the next tournament, I'd like to recommend to the Organizing Committee to arrange a bigger number of minibuses, therefore

the OC had some small problems with the transport from the Airport and in the local transport from and to the Venue during

the tournament too.

**Sport equipment -** Good, all were ITTF approved.

**Light in the hall** - Although we didn't receive any protest from the players

concerning the light, I'd like to recommend to the Organizing Committee to set new, modern light bulbs into the lanterns. Maybe with less total Watt could be obtained a better light for

playing.

**Information**: Good, both on the information board than in the pigeon-holes.

**Referee:** Very good and professional work

**Deputy referee:** Very good and professional work

Umpires: 25 umpires coming only from Spain, alternating in the hall during the three

days of the tournament. Although they were of a very good level, I have to recommend the OC to invite for the next tournament some umpires from abroad, for a better feeling of the players and

to maintain the neutrality in focusing matches.

**Computer man:** Only one man, working very hardly and in a excellent way, but

for the next tournament he will need still one good helper.

**Organization :** The organisation of the play was arranged very friendly and all the

events finished on time. Maybe for the next tournament could be better to organize Medals ceremony always after the end of each

event.

**Org.** Committee: The organization of the whole tournament wasn't bad, but it was

possible to see, that the number of the real working members of the OC during the tournament, was too small. I'd like to

recommend for the next Fa 20 tournament to complete the OC

with minimum the following persons:

One transport officer – fully responsible for all the transports. One Venue director - fully responsible for all the matters in the

playing hall.

One economical officer for all financial matters.

I am sure that if Vicente and Carlos will find the right persons for these jobs and will give them the full responsibility in their work,

the whole organization will be much easier for them.

It was the first ITTF PTTD Fa 20 tournament in Rivas Vaciamadrid and to my mind, the OC strove to work better and better. They seek to acquire advises from the officials and therefore, the level of the organization was increasing every day. I am sure that the next year if they will exercise the experience of the tournament 2009, they will, for sure, organize an excellent 2<sup>nd</sup> International Rivas Vaciamadrid Open Table Tennis Championships!

To conclude, I would like to congratulate with the Organizing Committee, referees, umpires and volunteers, for the well organized ITTF PTTD Fa 20 Tournament 2009 in Rivas Vaciamadrid.
