Venue: Asian Games Town Gymnasium

New venue they use them 1st time during the Asian Games for 4 sports and now only for Table Tennis. Full accessibility for wheelchairs players and the seating capacity was about 4.000 seats.

FOP 14 Double Fish tables accessible by wheelchairs players.

Training and warm up area: 16 same as FOP

Floor: Table tennis sport floor TAIAO TRIOMPHE (Red) (China).

<u>Light</u>: Very good, more than enough according the TV request

<u>Referee's tables:</u> Inside to FOP with best view to all tables. In the middle of the smaller side of FOP with a lot of chairs together with Technology manager and the Timing and Scoring coordinator.

Results Services: every table has on line results system in the small screen on the corner of table and in the central video board every 5 seconds updated. They used the same company as in Athens and Beijing, Athos Origin, and they used the same as Olympic and Paralympics system of information's (ORIS). There was internal system of information "INFO" in all accommodations site the central press center and in all venues

<u>Organization office</u>: a lot of rooms for all functions according to Olympic and Paralympics chart. Special rooms from TD, Referee, Deputy Referee, Jury, Chief classifier, classification staff, umpires, Racket control, etc...

<u>Accessible toilets</u>: in the Venue were 30 toilets accessible for the wheelchairs, in the level of FOP and the level 2 and 3 to spectators area

Classification: Classification was conducted in special area inside the training site with enough

space. All information for classification including to attaching file. (No2)

Results: There was two difference system, a official system of Asian Games under the

procedure of Paralympics Result and Information System (PRIS) with direct

information to Main Press Center and to online information to INFO2010 and the website of games. This system works inside the FOP and transfer the information to the board on the table (every table to large screen) life and to main screen board every 5 seconds and the system of Dr Wu who use basely for all competition needs

Medical service: There was under the medical services of IPC and APC. There was all the times one

doctor in the training – warm-up area and one doctor on the FOP. There was a first aid room with nurses and volunteers. There was ambulance always out of the venue.

<u>Ceremonies</u>: Medals Ceremonies were organized well, followed the protocol of Paralympics

Games.
