CONCLUSION

*The problem with the lift still stands; it broke down on the second evening causing significant problems getting the players to the table for the final round and therefore delay finish.

The organizers did very well in organizing the fire service to carry the players in the wheelchairs up and down the stairs to minimize delays. The lift was repaired by the next day.

As noted last year 2 new lift has to be built.

A ramp from ground to playing level would be a viable alternative to provide independence for the players.
