# **Training hall:**

There were 16 tables with wooden floor.

**Lighting:** Suitable about 1100 LUX

**Rest rooms**: 1 for men and 1 for women with 2 accessible toilets but with a lot of toilets in each one of them, with showers also, in grand floor

#### Meals:

• Lunch served in the special area in the venue.

The first day with all people eating at the same time, we had a problem of waiting time before being served. So the next days was resolved this opening another restaurant area in the floor -1 for volunteers, umpires, referees and officials, and the problem was resolved.

- There was also a bar at the entrance of the venue, serving coffees, teas and drinks with some snacks or cakes.





**Water:** Water was available during whole tournament – bottled in 0,5 –. There were

also water fountains in the venue.

**Classification:** Very close to the playing hall, three rooms.

**Medical service:** Doctor Team presented all the time in the playing hall.

**Umpires:** Changing and restroom for umpires.
