Accommodation: Organizing Committee used the Hotel Eger & Park, for all participants, except the

Hungarian Umpires. Accessibility was good as noted in the inspection report.

Meals: Breakfast lunch and dinner in the hotel in high level quality.

Transport: The transport between Budapest and Eger was organized very well.

Because the weather was very nice we didn't need transportation between the hotel

and standing hall (5 minutes walking distance).

Venues: There were two different Venues:

Wheelchair hall

Inside the hotel a total area for 750m² (hall 5 and hall 4) with wooden floor used for 9 tables, *Lighting:* was enough 600 lux. No day light. Accessibility to the hall was without problem. Gluing area was outside the hotel but nobody was gluing. Training site for all players were the halls 1-2-3 with 6 tables. Classification room was big enough inside the hotel near the training area. Pigeon boxes near the entrance of hall 4-5, for result board we used the wall near the organizing committee and a glass panel inside the hall 4.

Rest area was close to halls 1-2-3-4-5, big enough with a lot of tables and chairs for all, players, officials etc.

We used 9 tables full accessible for wheelchair players. **Referee's tables:** in the middle with good view

Computer people: by the referee place

Wheelchair storage: on the entrance of playing area

Meeting room : 20 meter from wheelchairs' playing hall

Internet access: Via wi-fi on ground floor and in the wheelchairs'

playing hall in the hotel.

Offices : we use the organizers office on ground floor.

Standing Hall

600 m from hotel was the standing venue, dimension ($42 m \ X \ 22 \ m$), wooden floor with poor quality wood with a lot of colours and especially the white one(problems with white ball). Lighting was enough about $700 \ lux$, no day light. Gluing area was outside of venue but nobody was gluing. The standing venue was accessible only on ground floor for players but not for spectators.

We used 10 tables.

Referee's tables: small table in the middle with good view

Computer people: in a loft overlooking the hall

Accessible toilets: in the Venue there were 6 toilets accessible for the

wheelchairs

Ball boys/girls: Every day approximately 15 - 20 ball children were present in both halls. They

worked very well, during the whole tournament; there were small problems later afternoons but organizers worked instead of them. At the next time should be put

in quotation a coordinator responsible ever-present.

Meetings: A technical meeting was held on March 10th, at 21:00 pm in the Meeting Room at

1st floor of Hotel. Organizers gave general information + draws and time

schedule for the first playing day to delegations.

Classification:

CLASSIFICATION COMMENTS

1/ Facilities for classification were very well prepared both room and equipment. Located in Hotel of accommodation of all players and PTT staff, very good accessible. 2/ According the PCF we classified total 23 players.

Classifications were done according the Schedule prepared with organizers, avoiding waiting in front of the classification room. Started 9th of March 9 a.m., continuing all day long until 10 p.m., then next day 10th. of March from 9 a.m. and finishing at 6 p.m. There were 8 reviews, 6 on demand of players, and 2 to change former standing classification to sitting, because of no possibility to play as standing anymore.

All others were new players.

Results after observation during tournament:

Reviews on demand of players /country/: 6, no change of class

Reviews from previously standing to sitting: 2, both eligible as class 5

All new players classified as eligible, 2 will stay under review, after 1 and 2 years. Copies of all classification cards added.

Observations during single and team events were done for confirmation of class, one classification was after observation changed.

3/ Class 5 checking:

We did classification evaluation of 2 class 5 players classified in the past. Both were founded as eligible in class 5. /Copies of classif. cards added/

4/ Others:

We approved one non standard system of safety fixation, not giving any advantage of stability to the trunk in class 2, only avoiding falling down. /Copy of ICC added/. Classification without extraordinary situations.

Umpires: Without problems. Of course the level of umpiring was not the

same as usually for all tournaments around the world.

Computer men: Very good team's work – always in time and well.
