IPC late reallocation due to Russian rejection

The conditions a player should be able to replace a open slot are the follow:

- \Box The athlete needs to be re-activated on the accreditation "long list".
- □ The athlete needs to fulfill the eligibility criteria for entry into the Games by the Sport Entries deadline of 15 August 2016. Please consult the Qualification Guide for the specific eligibility criteria that apply to your athlete, particularly with regard to classification.
- □ The online Sport Entries system is now closed. Please contact your NPC Services Coordinator at Rio 2016 immediately to facilitate this late entry.

Para Table Tennis had 9 Russian players selected.

From these 9 slots, only 5 were possible to replace but from this 5, one NPC refuse the slot and not any other NPC had a player from the same class on the Long List.

Consequently, only 4 slots were replaced and the unused 5 remaining slots go back to the IPC in the reallocation system.

By attached, in the single selection document you will find the replaced slots (names in red) and the unused slots (in green).

Moreover, we received yesterday a rejection of a lady F6 from UKR for medical reason (in yellow).

After discussion in the PTT SOC, it was decide to replace the unused slots by a "bye" and the "bye" will stay in the draw on last position to not destroy the full schedule already published since a lot of time.
