Bottled water was available for all at the venue.




Transportation:

Transport between airport and hotel and vice versa was well organized.

Also from hotels to the venue a big bus and a mini bus was used

Enough volunteers, (anytime ready) was helping players to reach the playing hall but this big ramb would be anyway a problem for a tournament with much more participants.

The shuttle service for both wheelchair and non-wheelchair users was available every one hour.



Venue, Competition Hall, Practice Hall

The National Center of High Performance Athletics (known as Ce.N.A.R.D. for its initials in Spanish: Centro Nacional de Alto Rendimiento Deportivo) is the sports complex where most Argentine sportspeople who compete internationally are trained.

In competition hall there were 12 competition tables, 6 for wheelchair players and 6 for standing.

Toilets were almost enough for this number of participants but it could be a little more clean



Volunteers- About 5-10 girls not enough sometimes

Lighting: Approximately 600 LUX

Spectator Seats: 2000 spectators seat

TD's and Referre's Table: On a platform very convinience to watch all the playing hall.

Medical service: A doctor and a phisio at the venue always ready to help.

Lounge: A lounge for the umpires was provided.

Sports Equipment:

Practice hall:

A practice hall, in an other building with 7 tables was provided for the players to practice.

Call area : In the playing area, in one corridor but not enough space, so for the team events it was decided to use also the other corridor.

Evaluation:

- * Accommodation was good in three hotels.
- * **Meals** which were served in Cenard were tasted but not of a good variation.
- * Venue is situated on the 3rd floor of the building. Volunteers were always ready to help the

players to pass the ramp. In the venue there are 2 only toilets (2 for men and 2 for women) which number is satisfied for this number of participants. But if the number would be increaced in the future it would be a problem. It would be recommended for more attention on the cleanliness of the sport venue. Also in the venue there are not accesible changing-rooms for players.

- * Sport equipment: good, ITTF approved
- * During the competition the behaviour of coaches, players, delegations was good.
- * The cooparation with the **match officials** and the **classifiers** was exellent. Also the **computer men** did good job.
- * Referees did good job too.
- * Umpires were of different level.
- * **Ceremonies** were simple.
- * Transportation was good organized .
