Meals:


All breakfasts and evening meals were served at the hotels, all athletes and officials had lunch at venue restaurant - Food was good but sometimes struggled with speed of service when busy.



Venue: Sala Polivalenta, Cluj-Napoca Romania

The Polyvalent Hall, finished in 2015, is a multi-purpose indoor arena used for numerous international sports events in Cluj-Napoca, with space to seat 10,000 people. It is considered as the best arena in Romania.






Referee and TD Table:

Close to the playing area in the center of playing hall.

Floor: Wood sprung sports flooring.

Lighting: Approx. 700 Lux over tables.

Practice Tables: 6 x Joola Practice Tables on other side of playing hall.



Equipment (All ITTF approved):

Tables: 14 tables Donic blue all wheelchair accessible, (8 for standing, 6 for wheelchairs)

Nets: Donic

Balls: Donic 3* White (Plastic)

Scoreboards: Donic Umpire tables: Donic Towel boxes: Donic Surrounds: Donic



Volunteers: A good number of volunteers from local schools and The Little People Association were used throughout the event - They were very efficient and helpful from start to finish.



<u>Changing rooms:</u> 3 for men and 1 for women – 4 wheelchair accessible toilets in total.





Water: Many water machines were available throughout the venue.

<u>Call Area:</u> Arranged in large corridor next to playing hall - WC and standing tables separate.



<u>Classification:</u> The classification room was between the practice area and call area. 19 athletes were classified during the tournament. The classifiers worked well during the tournament.



Other services:

- o Computer center, print service and staff were situated in own office shared with Referee & TD.
- o Wi-Fi Internet available to everyone at hotels and venue.
- o Pigeon holes using folders to give team leaders information.

Results Service: Elisabeta & Ileana inputting results in office assisted by a volunteer.



Medical service: Available everyday throughout the tournament. Ambulance present.



Information Boards: Updated regularly throughout the tournament.



Opening Ceremony: The opening ceremony was held at 12pm on 23rd March. The tournament was very privileged to be joined by His Royal Highness Prince Radu of Romania and the Mayor of Cluj Dr Emil Boc. The Mayor showed off his table tennis skills with one of the athletes.



<u>Medal Ceremony:</u> At the end of the Junior Singles event the medals were presented – For the main RITTO event the medals for singles and team events were presented after the completion of team event.



10th **Anniversary Farewell Party:** A Farewell party was held in the evening of the last day at the venue restaurant with a meal and celebration cake.


